2 SAMUEL 9

⁵ Then King David sent and brought him from the house of Machir the son of Ammiel, from Lo-debar. ⁶ **Mephibosheth**, the son of Jonathan the son of Saul, came to David and fell on his face and prostrated himself. And David said, “Mephibosheth.” And he said, “Here is your servant!” ⁷ David said to him, “Do not fear, for I will surely show kindness to you **for the sake of your father Jonathan**, and will restore to you all the land of your grandfather Saul; and you shall eat at my table regularly.”

2 SAMUEL 24

23 Everything, O king, Araunah gives to the king.” And Araunah said to the king, “May the LORD your God accept you.”

24 However, the king said to Araunah, “No, but I will surely buy *it* from you for a price, for I will not offer burnt offerings to the LORD my God which cost me nothing.” So David bought the threshing floor and the oxen for fifty shekels of silver. **25** David built there an altar to the LORD and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings. Thus the LORD was moved by prayer for the land, and the plague was held back from Israel.

2 SAMUEL 12

⁷ Nathan then said to David, “**You are the man!** Thus says the LORD God of Israel, ‘It is I who anointed you king over Israel and it is I who delivered you from the hand of Saul. ⁸ I also gave you your master’s house and your master’s wives into your care, and I gave you the house of Israel and Judah; and if *that had been* too little, I would have added to you many more things like these! ⁹ Why have you despised the word of the LORD **by doing evil in His sight?** You have struck down Uriah the Hittite with the sword, have taken his wife to be your wife, and have killed him with the sword of the sons of Ammon.

2 SAMUEL 12

¹² Indeed you did it secretly, but I will do this thing before all Israel, and under the sun.’” ¹³ Then David said to Nathan, “I have sinned against the LORD.” And Nathan said to David, “The LORD also has taken away your sin; you shall not die.

PSALM 15c

⁴ In whose eyes a reprobate is despised,
But who honors those who fear the
LORD;

He swears to his own hurt and does not
change;

⁵ He does not put out his money at
interest,
Nor does he take a bribe against the
innocent.

He who does these things will never be
shaken.

PSALM 27

27 The LORD is my light and my salvation;

The LORD is the defense of my life;
Whom shall I dread?

² When evildoers came upon me to devour
my flesh,

My adversaries and my enemies, they
