
**The Day That Changed My

Acts 3:1-11

Four aspects of this miracle are noteworthy:

1. it was unexpected,
2. it was done in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ,
3. it was instantaneous, and
4. it was complete.

The Cause & Effect of this Miracle



¹ Now Peter and John were going up to the temple at the hour of prayer, the ninth hour. ² And a man **lame from birth** was being carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple that is called the Beautiful Gate to ask alms of those entering the temple. ³ **Seeing Peter and John about to go into the temple**, he asked to receive alms. -- Acts 3

1. It Was Unexpected

⁴ And Peter directed his gaze at him, as did John, and said, “Look at us.” ⁵ And he fixed his attention on them, expecting to receive something from them.

⁶ But Peter said, “I have no silver and gold, but what I do have I give to you. -- Acts 3:4-6a

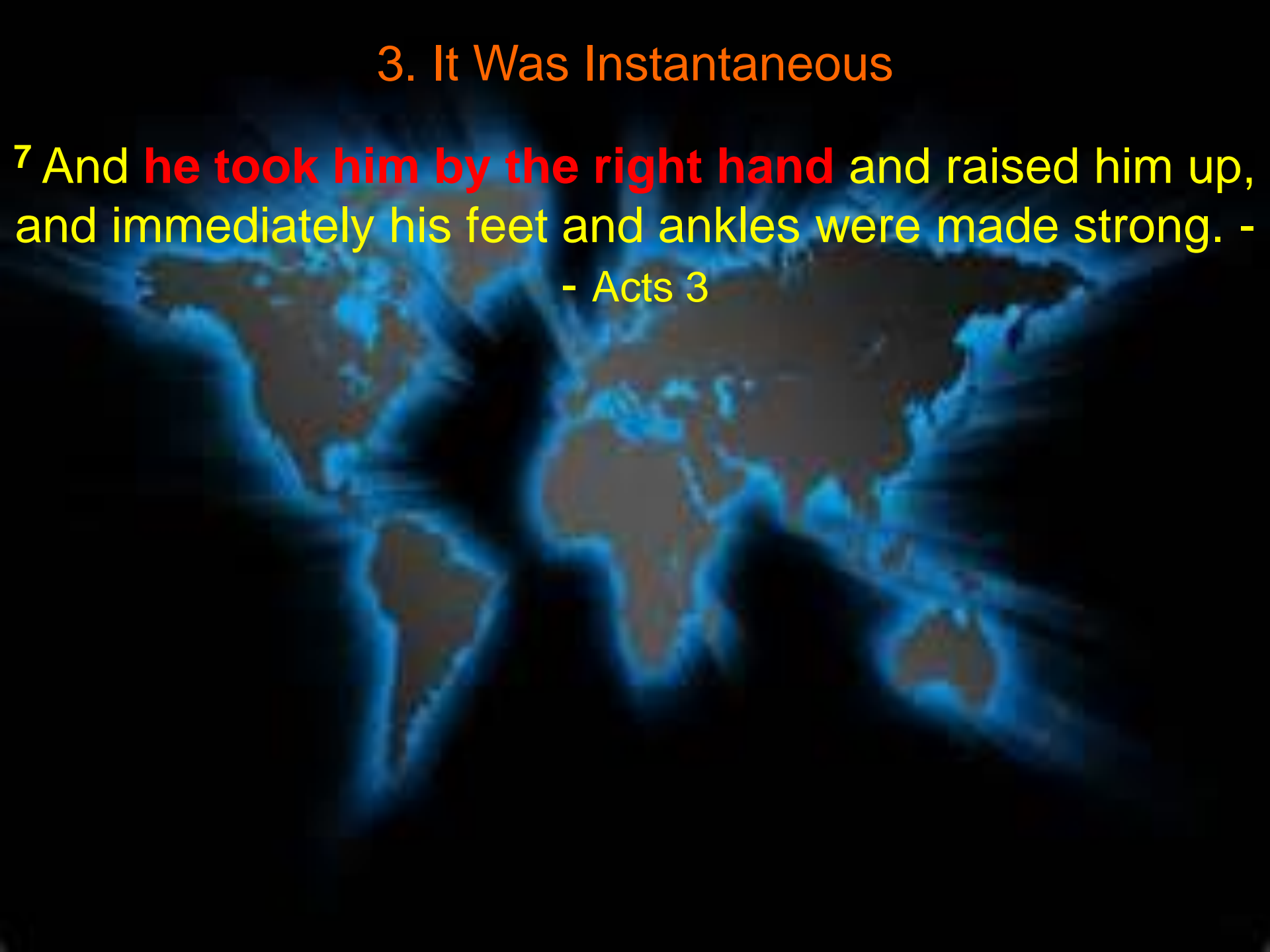
2. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk! – Acts 3:6b

⁷ And **he took him by the right hand** and raised him up, and immediately his feet and ankles were made strong. -

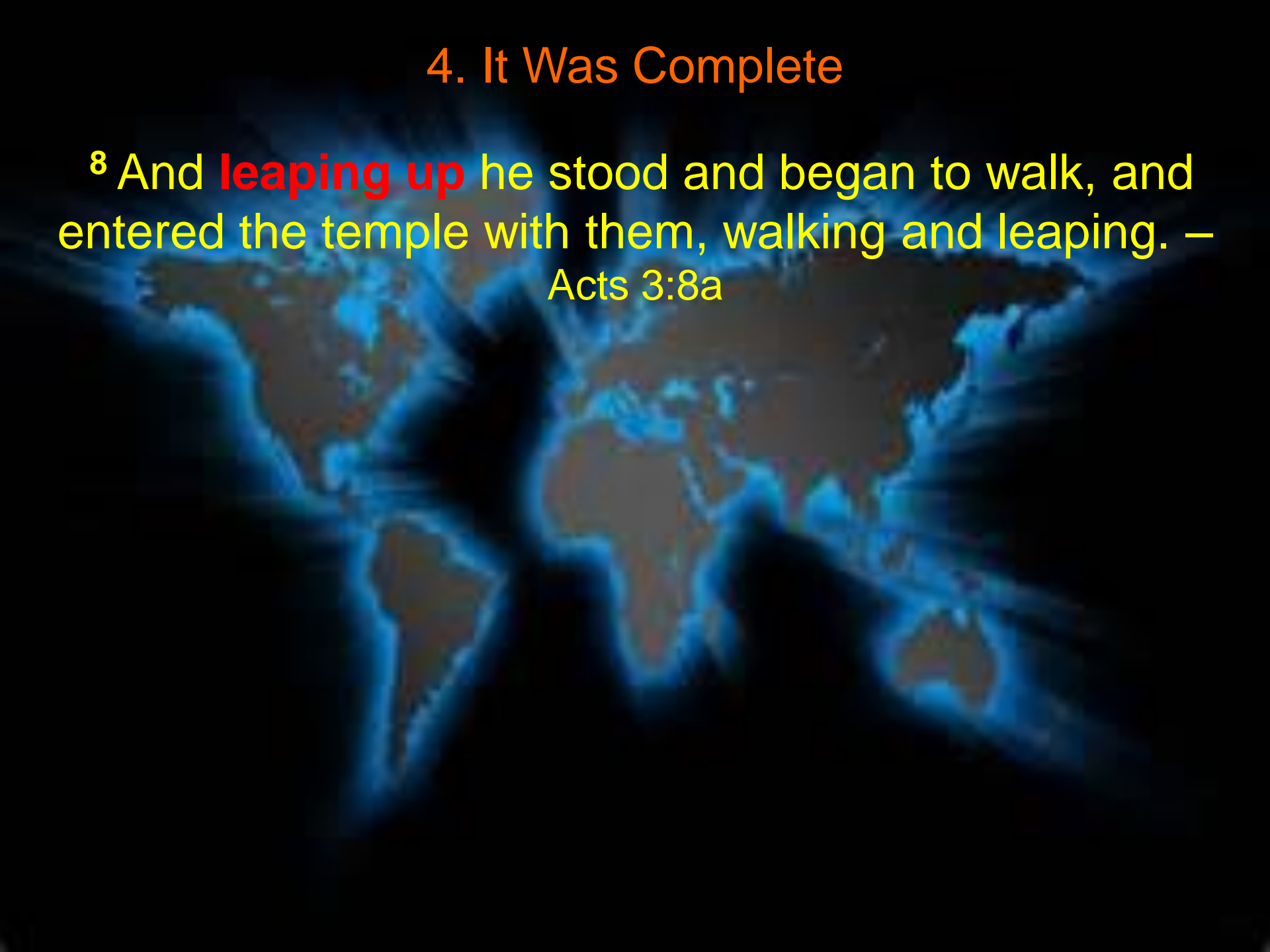

⁸ And **leaping up** he stood and began to walk, and entered the temple with them, walking and leaping. —

Acts 3:8a



The Cause and Effect of the God's Miracle
